2nd A sum of money about sixty or seventy dollars in the
hands of my Guardian Michael Goddard.
3rd A claim against the Steam boat Cleopatra for wages
of about twenty seven dollars.
4th A sum of money coming to me from my mother's estate
in Penna.
I also name and appoint my brother Zachariah
Executor for the purpose of fulfilling my
