

I John McCahlan of the County of Jefferson and State of
Kentucky do hereby make my last will and testament in manner
and form following, that is to say.

First I will with and bequeath to my eldest son William McCahlan
One young iron grey mare, now three years old, a silver watch
saddle which is known by the name of his and bridle, all of which
together I consider worth ninety dollars specie at the present time.
2nd I also give and bequeath to each of my other two sons, namely
John H and Benson McCahlan a horse, saddle and bridle to be
worth ninety dollars specie. It is my will that it should be
made up to them out of some other property.

3rd I give, with and bequeath likewise to my daughter Amanda
McCahlan a horse, saddle and bridle worth ninety dollars
specie to be given to her also when she arrives at lawful age.
And Lastly, I give and bequeath to well beloved wife Sarah
McCahlan the plantation I now live on containing by survey
141 acres, with all and singular the hereditaments and appur-
tenances thereunto belonging, together with my waggon
stock, farming utensils, household and kitchen furniture, with
all and every description of property (except the above named be-
quees) to be freely possessed and enjoyed by her during her natural
life, after defraying out of it all my lawful debts. And after her
decease, it is my will that the whole be sold and equally divided
amongst my above named children.

And I do hereby appoint and claim that Daniel Amer my friend
be and is to be my executor.

Stock, farming utensils, household and Kitchen furniture, and
all and every description of property (except the above named
pieces) to be freely possessed and enjoyed by her during her natural
life after defraying out of it all my lawful debts And after her
decease, it is my will that the whole be sold and equally divided
amongst my above named children.

And I do hereby appoint and declare that Harriet Amer my friend
be and he is hereby appointed as Guardian to my surviving chil-
dren, to do and act for them in all the functions pertaining
to that office that may be necessary, at the same time renun-
cing and disannulling all other wills or testaments heretofore
made by me, this and this only as my last will and testament.
