one Shilling and no more of my Estate —

Item I Give and bequeath unto my two Sons
Richard Parish and Heskiah Parish
all my lands to be equally divided
between them both unless my son Richard
should choose to keep the land whole
and to purchase his Brother Heskiah's land
elsewhere to the amount of the one half
of the land on which I live to them and
their heirs forever —

Item I give unto my grandson James Holt one
hundred yearling at the time he comes to the
age of ten years old to him and his heirs
forever —

Item I do hereby constitute and appoint my
dear Wife Easter Parish to be sole
Executor of this my last will and testa-
ment in testimony whereof I have set
