Exam^d I John Stewart a Citizen of Jefferson County
Record and State of Kentucky being very sick in body
\$0.83 but of sound and disposing mind and
memory calling into my mind the uncertainty
of human life do make and publish this
my last will and Testament in manner
and form following -

Imprimis It is my will that all my Just debts &
funeral Expenses be paid as soon as con-
veniently may be my Executors hereon
after named -
I leave it entirely at the discretion of my
Executors if they see cause to dispose of

Perishable property on such terms and
at such time as they shall think proper.
Item It is my will that my wife Eliza with Steu-
-art shall live on my plantation
whereon I now live and that all the
rents and profits of my lands and prop-
-erty shall be applied towards her
maintainance and the Education
and Schooling of my Children
I do hereby particularly request that so far
as my Estate is or will be sufficient it
shall be applied towards the Schooling
of my Children

Item all my Land and Property Consisting in
lands lots in Louisville or any other
Town or place shall remain undivided
untill my Children namely Isaac Sam-
-uells & John arrive to the age of twenty one
years provided my Executors or the sur-
-vivor of them should think it more
profitable for my Children to have it
sooner divided in either case my Executors
shall choose three disinterested and
Intelligent persons who shall value or
Appraise my Lands Lots and every
one of my above named Children
shall receive one equal Share in said

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thereof and if my said Children should die
about the Cheque of the Lands or any of the
my Cheque or shall either leave the debt
on thereof to my Executors or they may on any
bills for it such part of my Land and prop-
erty as shall respect to it fall to the share
any of my said Children each of them shall
have the said part or share of Land
for himself his heirs and assigns forever

Item As I have in my hope for a bond for
one hundred Acres of Land in the State
Country I would have the same when it
can be obtained on the same footing
with my Other Lands
