

In the name of God Amen!

I John Withers of Jefferson County and State of Kentucky lying on my death bed and believing that I shall not rise and testament
Wish I will and bequeath unto my wife Sarah Speak Withers following property Viz. One negro woman named Hanner, one negro man named Posh, One other man named Dick, One girl named Dinah. I also wish her to have a portion of the stock, as will be sufficient to support her, and the balance sold to the highest bidder and equally divided amongst my legatees.
Secondly I bequeath to my daughter Mary Withers one negro woman named Betty, my riding horse Rock and a good bridle, and to George my patient lever watch and my large shot gun.
Fourthly I bequeath to my Grand Son William Brooks a negro boy named Albert.
Fifthly I bequeath to my Grand Son Reuben Withers, son to Hiram Withers one negro boy named George. And all the balance of my negroes to be equally divided amongst all of my children, except that my son Charles shall pay out of his portion of his estate One hundred dollars to be equally divided also amongst my legatees.
Given under my hand and seal this 7th day of Sept 1814 in the presence of two witnesses.
