

In the name of God Amen I, William H. Bell of the County of Jefferson and State of Kentucky, of sound mind and perfect memory do hereby certify that I have made, revised and perfected this my last will and testament in the manner and form following: *Witness my hand and seal this 1st day of March 1881.*
Item First. I give to my son Thomas as his part of my estate which I am now about to acquire a whole lot of timber as timber maker and Mechanic.

Item Second. I give to my daughter Sarah Thennison the sum of ten shillings.

Item Third. I give and bequeath also to my daughter Elizabeth D. Bell all my bedding and household and kitchen furniture, not otherwise herein expressly disposed of.

Item Fourth. I give and bequeath unto my little daughter Frances Bell to defray the expenses of her education the sum of forty dollars to be paid out of any monies belonging to my estate. Also I give to my said daughter Frances one bed and furniture as a special legacy.

Item Fifth. It is my will and wish that all my estate, real personal and mixed be by my executor hereinafter constituted and appointed, collected, sold and disposed of for money at such time and in such way as to my said executor or executors may seem most advantageous to the legatees under this my last will and testament, excepting from said sale all special legacies herein before made.

them equally all the monies arising from the sale of my estate

Seventhly and lastly I do hereby name Conghite and Effie
Laurance Young of the County and State before first mentioned
Executor of this my last will and testament to carry into full
force and effect the several articles and provisions thereof,
hereby revoking all former wills, Codicils &c by me at any time
heretofore made
