Levi Russell
Esq

I Levi Russell of the County of Jefferson and State of Kentucky do make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form as follows to wit:
First. It is my will at my decease that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid by my executor hereafter named.
Secondly, I leave all my land, one horse, one bed and bedding, two cows, one sow, six chick, five heads of sheep and half the kitchen furniture to my beloved wife Nancy Russell so long as she remains a widow.

Thirdly, I give to my oldest daughter Sally intermarried to Joseph Marshall one dollar currency of the United States.
Fourthly, I give to my daughter Abigail intermarried with Thomas Smith one bed and bedding, one cow and yearling, three heads of sheep which they have received.

Fifthly, I give to my second son James Russell all my land which he is to receive at the expiration of my wife's widowhood for which he must take care of the minor children of my bowels and give them common education so far as to read and write plain and he is to receive no other portion of my estate.

Sixthly, All my other property not before mentioned it is my will shall be sold, and the money arising from the sale thereof to be equally divided betwixt Miriam Russell, Nancy Russell, Levi Russell, Livia Russell, Noah Russell and Mary Russell my six children not before mentioned.

Seventhly, and lastly, I appoint my friend Richard Fenton executor of this my last will and testament.

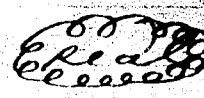

widow for the benefit of the family and at her decease or my
marriage that it shall be sold and divided as directed in the
sixth article of this will. And also I name and nominate
my friend Thomas Waller to act as Executor jointly with
the above and first named Executor
