The other half to be equally divided between Benjamin Pope, Martin Jewell, Joel Peager, Rufous Wilhite and Joshua Christy.
I acknowledge this to be my last will and testament whereof I have hereunto set my hands and affixed my seal this 27th day of December 1820.

At a County Court held for Nelson County, in the State of Kentucky at the Court House in Louisville on the 11th day of May 1821
