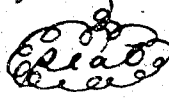


In the name of God Amen I Martha Crawford of the County of

held for the County of Jefferson at the Court house in the City
of Louisville on the fifth day of December 1831
An Instrument of writing purporting to be the last will
and testament of Martha Crawford dec'd who departed this
life in this County where she resided at the time of her death
was produced in Court and proved by the oaths of John A
Simrall and Thomas W Locke two of the subscribing witnesses
it was established to be the last
