and dispose of the same in the following manner and form
First I give and bequeath to Amelia Plaster my dearly beloved
mother, whom I likewise constitute, make and ordain the sole
Exectrix of this my last will and testament all and singular
my lands and personal estate by her to be freely to be possessed
and enjoyed for and during her natural life time; but should
my mother die before my youngest sister becomes of age or
get married, then all of the proceeds of my whole estate both
real and personal must be given to my three youngest sisters for
their education and maintenance until they get married or be-
come of lawful age and when all three of them become of lawful
age or get married, then the whole of my estate both real and personal
to be equally divided between all of my brothers and sisters. And

should my Mother think proper to sell any part or the whole of my
estate, she may do so by the consent of the majority of my brothers and

sole controul and advantage of all my estate both real and
personal for and during her natural life time. I do utterly dis-
allow, revoke and disannul all and every other former testament
will and legacies, bequests and executors by me in any wise be-
fore named, willed and bequeathed, ratifying and confirming
this and no other to be my last will and testament.
