

am 8 In the name of God Amen, I Mary Bullitt of the County of Jefferson and State of Kentucky, do make, constitute and ordain this my last will and testament.

Item ~~in~~ I give and bequeath to my daughter Eliza C. Prather four hundred dollars, I likewise give her my gray horse and her choice of any four beds and bedding which I have to her and her heirs forever. Item ~~in~~ I leave in trust to my brother Samuel Churchill for the use and maintenance of my brother William Churchill the sum of six hundred dollars, and I hereby invest my brother Samuel Churchill with full power and authority to purchase a negro man with the money if he may think it advisable so to do and to apply the hire of said negro as he may think it advisable for the support of my brother William Churchill; but it is expressly my desire that my brother William never shall have either the money or negro at his disposal, but that he shall receive the profits as the said Samuel may think necessary.

Item ~~in~~ It is my wish and desire that my stock of horses, cows, sheep and hogs, carriage and waggons, farming utensils of every description, together with my household furniture not already devised, likewise my kitchen furniture and also my crops on hand be sold.

Item ~~in~~ the balance of my estate viz. Perry, Bob, Molly, Mat, Rachael, Priscilla, Rose, Phillis and his wife Abby together with the balance and residue of my estate both real and personal after paying all my just debts I leave in trust to my brother Samuel Churchill and to be by him equally divided between my two youngest children

use due of my estate both real and personal after paying my just debts I leave in trust to my brother Samuel Churchill and to be by him equally divided between my two youngest children Mary Bullitt and Thomas James Bullitt whenever they may marry or become of age, but if either of them should die before they marry or become of age, then and in that case the property shall descend to the other surviving one and in case they both should die before they marry or become of age, then it is my wish and desire that the property so left in trust shall descend to my daughter Eliza C. Prather.

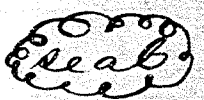
