First. After payment of all just demands against me, I devise all my estate real and personal to my youngest sister Elizabeth McConnell, to hold the same to her and her heirs forever.

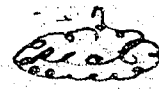
Second. I request and desire my brother in law Angeraw Gray to take the Guardianship of my sisters Elizabeth and David.

Third. I appoint Angeraw Gray the Executor of this my last will and request that no security may be required of him.

At a County Court held for Jefferson County at the Court house in the City of Louisville on the third day of October 1832
An instrument of writing purporting to be the last will and testament of Mary A McConnell decd late of said County was produced in Court and proved by the oaths of George Buchanan and Samuel Dickinson subscribing witnesses thereto and thereupon the same was established as the last will and testament of the said Mary A McConnell decd and ordered to be recorded and is recorded. And on the motion of Angeraw Gray, Executor named in said will execution thereof is granted him without giving security, it being so directed by said will.

In the name of God Amen this Seventh day of April Anno thousand eight hundred and twenty nine, I James Read Senr of the County of Jefferson and State of Kentucky, being weak in body, though perfectly sound in mind and memory, thanks be given to Almighty God therefore, calling into mind the mortality of my body, knowing that it is appointed for men once to die, do make this once to be my last will and testament. To wit: Principally and first of all I recommend my soul to God that gave it and my body to the earth to be buried at the discretion of my Executors and as touching my worldly estate of which I do possess, I wish them disposed of in the following manner To wit: I will and bequeath to my son James Read Senr the land
