mind do make this my last will and testament.
Item 1.st I give to Sister Sally a negro woman by the name
of Betty

I give Sister Nancy a negro by the name of Peter to lie
in the hands of my Executor until my fathers matters are settled
I give to my sister Lucy my horse and
bureau.

I give to my brother William One of my beds, I give
to my sister Sallys child Delia One Bed. I give to my brother
Walter Withers \$50 in the hands of my fathers Executors.
I give unto Jane Brooks my gold watch, to my mother a set of
table spoons from the hire of the negro left in my brother John
Withers hands for Maria Shadburn at her death

I give his daughter Frances a set of table spoons to have the
letters of my name engraved on the same
I give to my sister Elizabeth Shadburn my saddle and bridle

I also appoint my brother John Withers sole Executor to the
same, also that the Court shall not demand security of him on the
administration of said property, Whereunt. I have set my hand
and seal this 24th day of May in the year of our Lord 1831
