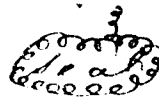


I Richard Llewellyn do make this my last will and testament
1st I give and bequeath to my son Jordan Llewellyn my negro man
Michael and my negro woman Nancy and her two children George
Richard and Beverly and her infant daughter Nancy.
2nd I give and bequeath to my son John Llewellyn a negro man
named James Banks, a negro woman named Theresa and her
three children two boys and a girl.
3rd I give and bequeath to my son Justinian Llewellyn a negro
woman named Mary Jane, a negro girl named Lydia Ann and
two boys named John Wood and William Harry.
4th I give and bequeath to said Jordan and John Llewellyn
or the survivor of them all the residue of my estate of whatever
description, in trust to be held by them to the separate use and
benefit of my daughter Eliza B. wife of Henry C. Dorsey; free
from any claim thereon by said Henry C. Dorsey or his creditors
I appoint said Jordan and John Llewellyn my Executors and
request no security may be required of them as such
The testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
seal this 20th December 1829

At a County Court held for Jefferson County at the Court house in the City of Louisville on the third day of September One thousand eight hundred and thirty

An instrument of writing purporting to be the last will and testament of Richard Llewellyn dec'd late of this County was produced in Court and proved by the oaths of Harves Mercer and William Pickels the two subscribing witnesses thereto and thereupon the same was established as the last will and testament of the said Richard Llewellyn and ordered to be recorded and is recorded. And on the motion of John R. Llewellyn and Jordan Llewellyn the Executors named in said will who made oath according to law execution of said will is granted them whereupon they gave bond in the penalty of Five thousand dollars conditioned according to law
