 First I Imprimis - It is my will and desire that my wife Mary Reynolds and my son Richard Reynolds shall be amply and sufficiently maintained out of my estate so long as they or either of them shall live
 Item - It is my will and desire that as soon as may be after my decease, my Executors hereafter named and appointed shall sell my negroes, Stock and other moveable personal estate on to the best credit - Item - It is my will and desire that the tract of land and plantation whereon I now live, shall be rented out by my Executors or the survivors of them and the rents and profits of the same shall be applied to the maintenance of my said wife Mary Reynolds and my son Richard Reynolds as long as they or either of them shall live
 Item - It is my will and desire that the said tract of land
