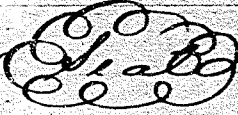


I Robert Coleman of Jefferson County and State of Kentucky

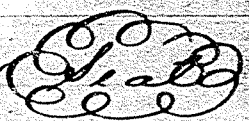
