First^m I resign my soul or ~~immortal~~ part into the hands of that Almighty and beneficent being who gave it, relying confidently on his justice and mercy.

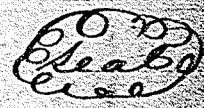
Secondly^m I give and bequeath to my dearly beloved wife Anna Ferguson during her life the house and lot whereon I now live containing two and a quarter acres, being part of five acre lot in the town of Louisville, known in the plan of sd town by number thirteen - I also give to my said wife during her life two thirds of all the rest and residue of my estate of every kind and description whatsoever and after her death I give and bequeath the said house and lot to my son Benjamin Ferguson to him and his heirs forever - I also give and bequeath unto my sons Samuel Ferguson, William Ferguson and George Ferguson after the death of my said wife, the two thirds of all that part of my estate herein before given to my sd wife during her life to them and their heirs forever -
Thirdly^m I give and bequeath to my son Benjamin Ferguson the other remaining one third of all my estate of every description to him and his heirs forever -

Fourthly^m I give and bequeath to my Grand daughter Mary Ferguson, daughter of my son John Ferguson one hundred and fifty dollars to be paid to her whenever she may leave my wife or when she shall marry or attain the age of twenty one years to her and her heirs forever - I do hereby request and authorize my

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to her and her heirs forever. I do hereby request and authorize my
friends Fortunatus Cosby, Thomas Prather, Mr. Gwathney and Cuthbert
and Thomas Bullitt or any two of them after my death to divide all
my estate (the house and lot excepted) into three equal parts, giving
to my wife two thirds as before directed during her life and
the other one third to my son Benjamin as before directed, re-
turning out of that part of my estate directed to be divided into
three parts a sufficient sum to pay the 1st one hundred & fifty dol-
lars to my said Grand daughter.

Lastly: I nominate, constitute and appoint my wife Executrix
and my sons John Ferguson and Benjamin Ferguson Executors
of this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all other
wills or wills heretofore made by me.
