Son James or to the survivor of them his or her Heirs
or Assigns for ever -

5th It is my will and desire that Nancy Careckson
and James Sneed shall be the Guardians of my said
Daughter & son.

6. I do hereby nominate & appoint the said James
and Nancy Careckson to be Executors & Co-executors of my
my last will and Testament hereby revoking all
other wills by me heretofore made and declaring
this my last will and Testament.
