uncertainty of this transitory life do make and publish this
my last Will and Testament in the manner and form
following to wit, principally and first of all I recommend
my immortal soul into the hands of God who gave it and
my body to the earth to be buried in a Christian like man-
ner, And as to such worldly estate whereunto it hath pleased
God to bless me with in this life, I give and dispose of the
same in the following manner, to wit. It is my will and I
do order that I be decently buried -

I give and bequeath unto my friends William
Dunn and Mary his wife of the town of Louisville State
of Kentucky, all my estate which is as followeth to wit
my tract of land containing twenty seven acres, lying
and being in the County of Lancaster State of Pennsylvania,
about one mile from Lancaster town, immediately on the
horse shoe road, which land was deeded by me by my father
John Richards and recorded in the County Court of Lancaster
and I left the original deed in the hands of Daniel
Haymaker and also the rent due me from the sd Daniel
Haymaker for the use of the said land.

And also my land which I am entitled to from the United States for my services as a private soldier in the last war, which this I charge in the hands of the said William Munroe will share and be entitled to the same, hereby revoking all other Wills, legacies and bequests by me heretofore made and declaring this and no other to be my last Will and testament.
