Estill a debt due him of about one hundred dollars and also satisfy him for any
legal cost and trouble he may be at in a suit concerning a piece of land he had
for me in Virginia. Item My desire is that my Executor pay to Rebecca Kellar out of the
proceeds of my estate one hundred dollars. Item My desire is that Betsey Evans and
Sarah Kellar, Sisters of Rebecca Kellar and daughters of Joseph Kellar each be paid by
my Executor fifty dollars each. My desire is that the balance of my estate remain in the hands of
my Executors until my brother Isaac Estill is satisfied for his cost, debt, trouble as before
stated. And lastly I appoint Richard Barlow Executor of this my last will and testament.
