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I Susan Fry of Jefferson County do hereby make my last will and testament in manner and form following. That is to say First I desire that all the perishable part of my estate be immediately sold after my decease (except what is hereafter excepted) and out of the money arising therefrom all my just debts and funeral expenses to be paid. Secondly. I give to Sister Rebecca Whipple one of my best beds and furniture during her life time and after her death to return to my children hereafter named. Thirdly I give to my daughter Polly Fry, one small bureau. Fourthly I give to my children Polly Fry and William Fry all the remaining part of my property, also my table spoons of all sizes (silver and cotton cloth on hand and all the spun and raw materials for making cloth. And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my brother Newton Whipple Executor of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former wills by me made.
