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I Thomas Gibb being in sound mind have this day willed and bequeared to my beloved wife Elizabeth all my estate both personal and real to use and do as she thinks proper with so long as she remains a widow; But if she should marry, my Executors must put her to her thirds and the balance to be equally divided among my children.

I also point my beloved wife Elizabeth as one of my Executors and my brother George Gibb as the other. This is my last will and testament Given under my hands this day and date above mentioned
