my said Wife can make use shall be sold by my Executor
and the money arising out of the sale shall be paid to her.
It is my Will that my Wife shall keep my plantation which
now here containing seventy two acres in her possession and the
said plantation shall be rented under the direction of my
Executor and the rents and profits arising therefrom shall be paid
to her for her maintenance as long as she remains my Widow
and in case she should choose to marry again my said
Wife shall only be entitled to the third part of the Rents and
Profits aforesaid - the other two parts of the said Rents and
