I William Hargrave of Jefferson County, State of Kentucky
make and ordain the following as my last will and testament
I give to my much beloved
wife Lucy during her life time the tract of land I at present
own with the house, furniture, stock of horses, cattle, sheep, hogs,
farming utensils and all articles appertaining to said tract
of land.

I also give to her to dispose of as she may think proper
five hundred acres of land in Clear Creek, Shelby County,
house at the corner of fifth and Main Street in the City of
Bowling Green, Kentucky and the house joining and below it on the
Street.

It is my will that my negroes continue under the
direction of my wife and Executors until my children are of age
and married or may acquire them, in which case I wish an equal
distribution of them to take place except of Malinda, and her
children, which I have given to Mrs. Emelia Clarke. Such of my
children as have received any of my negroes will account for
them and allow their education when the distribution takes place.

I give to my son John the following land
of military lands in this State to wit 1536 2/3 acres on Clear
Creek Adams County, the patent is for 3200 2/3 acres, \$130 a acre.
The 1536 2/3 acres is to be conveyed to the person having an agree-
ment from the State, two surveys of 1000 acres each, laying out the
tracts of land in the Creek and Robin fork of said Creek in Adams
County, One of which is patented to me the 19th March 1784, and
the 11th January 1790. One other survey on waters of said

County, One which is patented to me the 19th March 1796
the 11th January 1798. Two other surveys on Waters of said
Creek containing two hundred acres each, patented to me
the 24th May 1792. 413 acres on Cumberland River at Nashville
patented to me Septemr 13th 1797. 800 acres Cumberland
County, including a Back Lick, patented to me
31st Novemr 1799 - 1300 Acres on Waters of Paint Creek, State of
