Item. I do hereby bequeath to my loving wife Ann Brigg the full use of all my property real and personal during her natural life and that she shall receive all benefits arising therefrom during the said time.
Item To my daughter Nancy Noel wife of Edmund Noel. I do hereby bequeath to her and for her use the place on which she now resides with her husband Edmund Noel, situated on the Ohio, bounded by the same Ohio, by Whistleberry Run and Francis Snowdens farm to her, her heirs and assigns forever in accordance to the provisions made in the preceding article.
Item I do hereby bequeath unto my son William Brigg the plantation on which I now reside, being the balance of my landed property not deeded nor devised to my other children at the decease of my wife Ann Brigg (and not before) to him, his heirs and assigns forever.

Item. At the death of my wife Ann Brigg I do hereby direct that my personal property shall be divided as follows Viz That my sons Daniel Brigg, Thomas Brigg and William Brigg and my daughter Nancy Noel (wife of Edmund Noel) and my Grand Son Daniel Quisenberry in lieu of his mother my daughter Mary Quisenberry wife of Thomas Quisenberry shall have the same equally divided between them the same to be divided by lot, which lots shall be made by three or more disinterested persons to be chosen by the Executors here-

Thomas Quenson shall have the same equally divided between
the same to be divided by lot, which lots shall be made by three
or more disinterested persons to be chosen by the Executors here-
after mentioned or named.

Item. To my children Mary Quenson (wife of Thomas Quenson) Nam-
brigg Thomas Brigg having already in my life time provided for
them any gave them their portion of my lands. I bequeath to them
no other legacy than mentioned in the preceding. Item. Leaving to
James Quenson my Grandson the share of my daughter Mary
Item. To Miss Anne Barry who I have raised from infancy I do be-
queath One hundred dollars to be paid out of my personal property
by the heirs before mentioned, Each one paying their proportion.
But the same is not to be paid till the decease of my wife Ann
Brigg, under whose jurisdiction all my property real and personal
is to remain during her life time. Item. Should any dispute arise
respecting the division of the property I request and lay injunction
that three or more disinterested persons shall be chosen
by the heirs who shall decide on the proper boundaries to be made
between them and that a fair division shall take place within
one year after the decease of my wife Ann Brigg. Item. I do hereby
name and appoint my sons Daniel Brigg, Thos Brigg and William
Brigg my Executors to this my last will and testament and I do
hereby authorize the aforementioned Executors to take in trust the
aforementioned farm demised to to Nancy Cook under their
charge for her use without any restrictions or hindrances from
husbands who is not considered a heir or having any claim
the provisions here made but for her only, her heirs and assigns
to sit my hand and seal.
