adjoining Middletown in the County and State aforesaid with all the
appurtenances thereto belonging.

I also give unto my son Joseph
one silver watch and to my daughter Mary Ann my gold watch
and as to the residue of my goods and effects of every kind what-
ever I give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary Ann and Henri-
etta Equally. In Witness whereof I do hereunto set my hand and
seal this 21st day of March 1833
