In the first place I give and devise all my property both real and
personal to be divided amongst all my children - named as follows -

Henry Porter and Julia Ann Porter, In the second place if Edward Bran-
ton should not redeem a certain obligation or bond for the conveyance
of certain tract of land which is now in my possession, I leave
it to the choice of Doctor James Porter to take the said bond and have
the land conveyed to himself by paying my children twelve hun-
dred dollars - In the third and last place I leave Doctor
James Porter my Executor with full power to hold all my estate
in his hands till my daughters marry or my son Henry arrive
to the age of twenty one year by paying the interest annually
