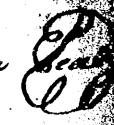


In the name of God amen. I William Watson of

in the manner and form following (that is to say) First I do

black Mare bred this Spring - Item I give & bequeath unto my
Mother Erwin Watson of New Castle County and State of Del.
ware during her Natural life all the residue of my Estate (ex-
cept my Clothing which I leave to my Brother Thomas Watson
(son) real and Personal, and my desire is that after my Mo-
thers decease, that, that part of my Estate that is then re-
maining may go to my Youngest Sister Margaret Watson

Item I do hereby appoint Jacob Newland my Executor in
this my last Will and Testament and do desire that he will
see the same duly executed according to the true intent and mean-
ing of the same In Testimony of all which I have hereunto
