disease and rent of the plantation I sold to James
Doak agreeable to the article I made with him. Item
I allow her to keep one horse her lifetime & those remain-
ing to be sold & divided amongst my legal heirs &
will be hereafter specified, and if said horse creature
should die she is to be furnished with another of my Estate.
Item and it is my desire and intention to set my Negro girl
Charlotte free in twelve years from this date, nevertheless it is
be understood that my wife shall keep her her lifetime, &
if she should decease before that time S^d Negro is to go
to the use of my Daughter Jan^e Doak, and if S^d Negro
girl should have any increase before she is free, it is
my desire she shall be liberated at the age of twenty
