 being sick of body but in my right mind
 blessed be god for it, and willing to mind
 the transitory state of prepetual life that all
 men must yeald unto death have thought
 fit to make comtels and ordain this
 my last will and testament, hereby dis-
 approving all other wills and testaments
 heretofore by me made either by words
 or writing and I do ordain thus and thus
 only to be my last will and testament
 and committing my soul unto the hands
 of god and my body to be buried with
 decent and christian burial by my
 executors hereafter named I do order
 worldly affairs to be disposed of in form
 and manner following. But I
 will that all my debts and funeral
 expenses be paid in as short a time
 as possible after my decease also I
 bequeath to Francis Evans my horse and
 cow and bed and furniture, also James
 Evans my saddle and bridle also my
 landed property to be sold to the best
 advantage by my executors and the
 money when got to be divided as follow-
 vizt. Nineteen dollar to Polly -
 Susan and Nancy M. Hume ten
 dollar apiece, Denny Molly and Betsy
 Evans ten dollar apiece Polly M. Cornish
 ten dollar each Dary and Polly Brothers
 ten dollar each also the household and

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the expenses that is or may occur in
my disputes with others about my land
that my executors pay them ~~expenses~~ and

First one third to Nathaniel Evans

second one third to Andrew Evans

third one third to William M. Council

I do appoint and ordain Nathaniel
Evans and William M. Council to
be my executors of this my last will

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To all to whom these presents shall come know
that I Shadrach Moore of the County
of Sepamino and State of Kentucky, being then
in the late state of health but by the blessing of
God enjoying my senses perfectly, my mind unim-
paired having thought fit to make my will
bearing witness thereto by this be it the way
the truth and the life, I do by these presents
make and ordain this my last will and
testament My body I commit to the earth and
my spirit to the hands of Jesus, My Estate real
as well as personal I give and bequeath in the
following manner viz the first place I give
and bequeath to my beloved wife Rebecca Moore
and third part of my Estate both real and personal
during her lifetime widowhood and after death
it is to be equally divided amongst all my children
I give and bequeath to my three sons Jed Moore
Shadrach Moore and Jeremiah Moore all
my land viz the land on which I now live
also the tract on which James Cannon now
lives adjoining Rudy Calwood's dec'd David
Trasue and John Scott said tract containing
by estimation eighty six acres to be equally
divided, my said three sons as above
mentioned it is here to be observed that
the whole of my third third part as above
mentioned it is to be divided amongst all
my children after her decease the said
estate my wife's estate is equally divided
amongst all three of my sons as above mentioned
