worth forty five pounds one bed and furniture
to her & her children lawfully begotten
forever I lend all the remainder of my
estate be it of what nature or property soever
to my beloved wife Betty during her natural
life then to be equally divided between
my three daughters Fanny Elizabeth & Mary
& their children lawfully begotten forever

& my son in law John Eastman and my son
Richard Executors of this my last will and
