in manner and form as follows first it is my Will and

ainder of my Estate give and bequeath as follows first I

whereon I now live together with all my negroes
viz Dick Arthur Stephen Math Mahah and Peggy
and all my stock of horses cattle sheep and hogs and
also all my Household furniture during her natural
life after her death ^{decease} to be sold for the best
price as my Executors shall think best and
the money to be put to the use hereafter directed
I give my land in Logan County and Warren
County and after paying off three hundred acres of
land to my son Henry Chiles & David Chiles
out of my land on the Dry Ridge the balance of
the said tract to be sold with above land in
Logan and Warren together with all land my
son Henry Chiles, he being my attorney shall obtain
in Clarke County he reserving to himself as much
of what he shall gain for his trouble in attending
to the said sale to be sold what he shall
gain with the other land above mentioned and
as he desires that all my children should
have an Equal part of my

more than others it is my desire that they shall be
made up Equal out of the first part sold I shall
mention what I have given I have given to my son
John Chiles dead fifty pounds I have given to my son
Henry Chiles one hundred and fifty three Pounds
I have given to my son David Chiles one hundred &
fifty pounds I have given to my son James Chiles thirty
pounds also I have given my son Garland Chiles one
hundred and sixty eight Pounds also I have given to
my Daughter Ann Stone fifty two pounds also I have
given to my Daughter Elizabeth Gate forty seven
pounds also I have given to my Daughter Peggy Billars forty seven
pounds also I have given to my Daughter Sally
Dawning one hundred and ten pounds also
I have given to my Daughter Susanen (Wright) one
hundred and ten pounds now it is further my desire that the
residue coming to my son John Chiles and to make them
his part equal to his David's Equal equally among
all his children, and the money that is coming to
Susanen make Susanen (Wright) equal with
the rest to be Equal divided among all her children to
wit Sally Gate, Sophia Gate, Susanen Lucinda Gate &
Susanen (Wright) money coming to my Daughter
Ann Stone to be equal divided among all her children
at her death — and it is further my desire that after
my Wife's decease that the part left her to, sold and the
money arising therefrom to be equal divided among all
my children and Grand children as before mentioned
in my will of the all my children is made up equal

have given in trust to my Executors herein after mentioned

last will and testament. I recommend my

him (see Bill of Ex. made him) let all my will
and desire, that at my decease my negro
man Ben be freed. Consequently I do hereby
(at my death) let him said Ben free from
all bondage claimed by me or my heirs
Saves good and bequeath and bequeaths to my
beloved wife Petsy Stonestreet, and my daugh-
ter Joseph Stonestreet all the remaining
part of my estate of every species and dispo-
sition to equally divided between them & their
and their heirs forever. Lastly I do hereby
revoke and disannul all and every other
will or wills made by me heretofore.
And appoint my brother James Stonestreet
and my friend John Stentz my legal executor to
