Then I do give and bequeath to Eliza Burr my daughter in Law a child's part to be equally divided amongst her children the Heirs of Samuel Burr deceased as soon as she receives it or as the come of age then and I give and bequeath the balance of my Estate to be Equally divided amongst my children and grandson (to wit) James Burr, Nathaniel Burr, Alexander Burr, my Grand son John Carrow, Lunny Cook, Martha Woods and Leon Spears and at the Decease of my wife, the creature and household furniture to be sold and an equal division made of the money arising from its sale amongst my children above mentioned and do also constitute and ordain my son Nathaniel Burr and Joseph Woods the sole Executors of this my Last will and Testament and I hereby revoke all former wills and Testaments, ratifying this to be my last will and Testament in witness I have hereunto set my hand and seal this sixth Day of November one thousand Eight hundred and six.

In the name of God Amen, I Joseph Hewitt of Jefferson County, and State of Kentucky, am sensible of the mortality of this body and being in the Exercise of my right senses and memory and having a desire to settle all my temporal concerns, do constitute, and ordain this to be my last Will and Testament. In the manner and form following To wit

I give first I lend my beloved wife Polly (during her lifetime) two Negroes to wit Frank a man and Kate a woman and her child Malinda. And after her death the 2 Negroes and their increase and profits arising from their labour is to be disposed of as followeth first the two children that I have had by my said wife Polly is to be made equal in property of equal value to those children I had by my former wife and then the residue of 2 property and their increase is to be equally divided between all my children I also lend my wife one third of the tract of land I live on to include my dwelling house, I also leave my said wife two beds and furniture, also a sword horse and colt called Altha, and two cows and calves also in head of sheep. I also leave her twenty pounds worth of the other property. Then I now give to my daughter Polly 5 Dollars one mare saddle and bridle worth thirty five pounds, also one Negro named Rhoda at sixty pounds, one bed and furniture at twenty pounds and six pounds in cash all mine and her property. Then I give unto my daughter Sally the Hickman on Negro named Bertha at sixty

pounds and one mare saddle and bridle at thirty five pounds. And one bedstead and furniture at twelve pounds fifteen shillings. ^{Pr} of harkens irons and kettle six Dollars half dozen knives and forks Ten cups and saucers 8 Dollars. also one blue horse at twenty pounds, two Cows & lambs and four Geese at five dollars one bow and half ten dollars all which I have bequeathed to her. Then I give to my son Joel Prewitt one mare at eighty seven dollars one ox at nine shillings, one Negro boy named Rob. at seventy pounds one Cow and calf and yearling 20 shillings Bedsteads and furniture twelve pounds fifteen shillings, four hundred pounds pork 43. 12 shillings. 2 Cows and lambs & geese six plates 11. 14. 0 all which he hath rec^d. Then I give unto my Daughter Nancy Rice one Mare saddle and bridle at thirty five pounds, one Negro Girl named Oshea at sixty pounds one bedstead and furniture twelve pounds fifteen shillings. One cow and pigs at 10 shillings one pot and table twelve shillings all which I have gave her in possession. Then I give unto my Daughter Peggy Howard. ~~one~~ horse saddle and bridle at seventy dollars one Negro Girl named Betty at fifty pounds one bedstead and furniture at twelve pounds fifteen shillings. 700 lb. of pork at nine dollars. Again and bequeath to my son Rice Prewitt

one Negro boy named Ned. I give to my son Pleasant Prewitt one Negro boy named Sam I give to my Daughter Judy Prewitt one Negro Girl named Abster. Also my wish and desire is that there shall be a young Negro purchased out of the estate or sale of my movable property for my son Joseph Prewitt and that my four last mentioned children be educated out of my estate and my three sons put to trades at the Discretion of my Executors farther my will ~~intention~~ ^{is} that my Negroes mager Peter and Sarah be sold and all the residue of my Estate that is not heretofore given away both real and Personal to be sold at the Discretion of my Executors and all my just debts paid and my will and desire is that all my children be made equal and their Difrent Proportions given them as they come of age or married except those that are not of age or not to receive any more than they have already received until the amount of the estate can be ascertained. And lastly I constitute and appoint Robert Prewitt and David Prewitt William Prewitt Joel Prewitt and George Walker sole Executors of my estate.
