manner Viz. first of all I allow that all
my just and lawful debts and funeral
charges be punctually paid. Then I leave in
the possession of my beloved wife Mary the
third part of all my estate real and personal
during her natural life I allow my land
to be divided between my two sons Joseph
and Alexander equally at their mothers
decease I allow a negro boy to Joseph named
Moses with what property he now claims
as his own I allow a negro boy to my son
Alexander named Jesse with what property
he now claims as his own I allow a negro
boy named Elijah to my son William I
allow ^{my daughter Elizabeth} a negro woman named Leah with
her issue from this date and what she now
claims her own I reserve only two negroes
Tom and Eve for the support of my wife -
while she lives and at her decease to be sold
with my other property and an equal di-
vision to be made among all my children
Joseph, Samuel, Alexander Wm Squire, Mary
Rachael Margaret & Elizabeth.

And I do hereby constitute and ordain
this my last will and testament and do
make and disannul every other will.
