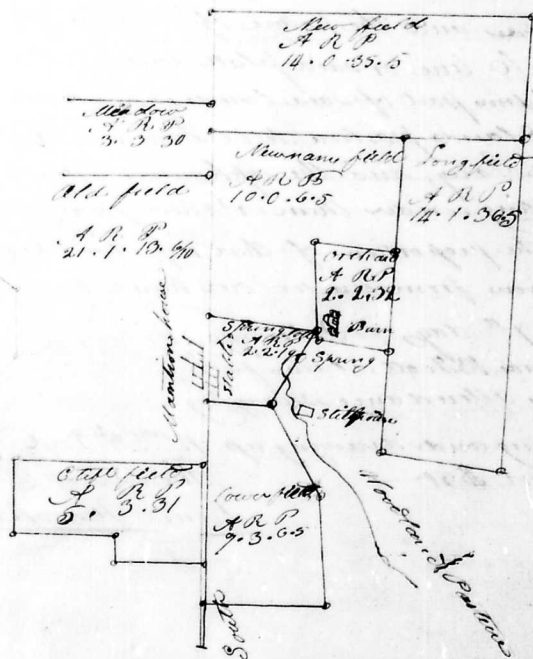

sound in mind & memory that I am aware
that it is appropiate to all men
to be so much & address that my last
will & testament in manner & form
following viz I give my body to be
buried to be buried in a Christianlike
manner & after all my last debts
are paid I direct that my last will
and testament there say of signed in
the year of our lord 1816 to be & myself
with as follows viz I give all my
real & personal estate to be equally divided
between my son Terence McGrath & my
daughter I give to my son Wm McGrath
my share and pocketed testament also my
Real property to be sold by my Executor
of this my last will Wm McGrath &
Mr Edward Wall as they shall think to
be best advantage I further direct they
shall state up each side a recounstanding
against them in my memorandum book
also that they collect all the due debts due
me by bond or note or to Interest on them
but it remembered my son in law pays
no interest to the Estate on their notes given
to me I further direct that each son
in law note the sum thereof be added
to their accounts standing against them
I further direct they shall settle with
my son Robert McGrath & his

accounts is in his hands, ~~with my son~~
I further direct that where I am taken
ill for death they shall be paid extra for
their trouble & my house and to be not
paid I direct my executor to sell to the
best advantage given bonds as they shall
think proper & when every thing is settled up
I direct my executor shall make in
