 my last will and testament in manner
 and form following Viz: First I give &
 bequeath unto my beloved wife Margaret
 Singleton the home and land on which I
 now live with all the household and kitchen
 furniture and the plantation toots and
 utensils of every kind also all my stock of
 cattle sheep and Hogs to her during her natural
 life or widowhood for the support of herself
 and family, also all my garden "Honeytree"
 and a Negro Woman named Rachel and
 Rachel's child named by "Hannah" my
 and Jerry to her my beloved wife during
 her natural life or widowhood as the
 other property is stated above:—

I also have given and bequeathed into my daughter Elizabeth Mason formerly to the amount of fifteen hundred dollars and a negro woman named Juliett and her increase for ever which I estimate being worth five hundred dollars also a bed and a saddle and feather bed and furniture which I estimate to be worth one hundred dollars total amount that I have given and that the said Elizabeth Mason has received is \$1000 Dollars; and to my daughter Martha Craig I have given and bequeathed in the same kind of property and to the same amount of \$1000 which the said Martha Craig has received, being equal with her sister Mason.

And to my beloved children who have not had any of my estate I give and bequeath to each of them after my ~~death~~ just debts are paid off namely as follows to

I named Singleton twenty one hundred dollars out of my estate when he the said Daniel Singleton comes of age to Sally Singleton I give twenty one hundred dollars out of my estate to be paid to her when she the said Sally Singleton marries or comes of age and to Sally Singleton I give twenty one hundred dollars out of my estate to be paid to her when she the said Sally marries or comes of age and to James Singleton to John Singleton to George Singleton I give to each one of them twenty one hundred dollars out of my estate to be paid to each of them when they come of age, But if any of my six last mentioned children should die having no heirs lawfully begotten of his or her own body then their estate shall be equally divided between those of the six that may be living, and none of my children is to be charged with raising, and of them my loving wife and each of my children have all got their parts as above stated if there should be yet a surplus of my personal estate it is to be divided equally amongst the six last mentioned children, My first two children named Elizabeth Mason and Martha Craig, twice and hegeath among them in equal share of both my out lands with the other six children, and I hereby appoint my beloved wife, Margaret Singleton and Elijah Carmell and Samuel Craig or my Executors and Executors of this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all former wills by me made signed sealed and published this my last will and Testament
