I, Nathan Baker of Jefferson County and State of Kentucky being weak in Body but of perfect mind & memory do hereby order constitute and appoint this my last will and testament in full and manner as follows I do will that all my just debts be paid by my Executor second I will that whereas my son Thomas Baker has Received in cash & property to the amount of two hundred and two lbs doct^r which is all the debt I have at present and as my son Dudley and my daughter whose name has not yet been declared of my estate

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quite as much as their Brother Thomas I will that the Balance shall be made up to them so as their parts shall be each of them equal to their Brother

Secondly I will that my two younger Children that is John & Margaret Baker shall each of them have an equal share of my estate so as their portions each of them shall amount either in cash or property some but not less than the number of two hundred & twenty lbs each

Thirdly I will that my beloved wife Nancy Baker shall enjoy and possess my farm and dwellings and all the residue of my estate during her natural life and at her decease all the residue of my estate together with my lands & tenements shall be sold and equally divided between my four children VIZ Thomas, Dudley, Sally, John & Margaret Baker

And lastly I will that my beloved wife Nancy Baker & my two sons Thomas & Dudley Baker shall be my executors of this my last will & testament In Confirmation whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 10 day of Dec^r 1817
