

In pursuance to an order of the Supreme Court two have occurred the vouchers and receipts of the Executors of Roger Patton died and have stated the acts according to the amounts it appears that they notes as in Partnerships between Roger Patton and John Patton the terms of the Partnerships are not defined, the amount of them are not ascertained there is a note in the name of David S. Arnold in the same situation: There is also an account of Pelly McDaniel, which is not defined in a way that we could ascertain the amount there was a bond which the Executors produced before us that James Patton held on the deed for the conveyance of two hundred & fifty acres of land in some part of this state equal in value to the lands on which the deed lived in an unimproved state by General Warrant the Executors have given their bonds to said debtors for one thousand dollars in exchange for the land bond we think the exchange advantageous to the estate of the deceased that we have received all sums paid by the Executors in discharge of the bond of 1000 dollars out of which is respectfully submitted
