 said wife Mary five hundred dollars in cash due
 me in the state of Virginia the balance of the money
 due to me in Virginia, I give to my Brother Henry
 Barnes also I give unto my nephew American Kentucky
 five negroes to wit, John and Donaldridges also I give

 to be delivered unto him he becomes of age,
