the disposing of my temporal estate which I do in the
 following manner and to wit I will that
 all my Just Debts be discharged as soon as conven-

ient after my decease. I will and bequeath to my
 Beloved Wife Martha Frost all my whole
 estate During her natural life and then to be

disposed of by her at her death as she may think
 proper except such things as is herein particu-

larly mentioned as my bond is out to John
 Sanford and William Bohan for the conveyance

of a certain tract of Land lying on the waters
 of Chaplin in Mercer County I do hereby auth-

orize and appoint my Son Simon Frost to
 make the Conveyance for the same as recd to

the Bond I will and bequeath to my Son John
 a horse Bridle and a Saddle The horse to be
 the one he now claims one Cow and a calf
 four sheep and one bed and furnature
 and one years schooling and to each of my

Children ten dollars in Cash and I do hereby
appoint My wife Martha Frost my son
Simon Frost & Brother Thomas Scott Executors
of my last will and testament in witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand &
Seal this 29th day of September 1810
