my negro man Sam and my negro woman Judy
with all my personal property except what is hereafter
mentioned - To my son David Sammons I leave
my Negro named America as he has got his legal
Divided of the rest of my property -
To my son John Sammons, I leave my negro
girl named Linda and to her heirs equal with
David and William - To my daughter
Riley I leave my Negro girl named Leah to be
and to equal with my daughter Jimmy in property
To my son, Archd. I leave in property a Negro
girl named Juliet and to her heirs equal in
property with my other three sons - To my
son Ben I leave a Negro boy named Dilligor
and to equal divide with my other four sons
in property - and Residues and remainders of my
personal property Estate belong to my wife Anne
for life time and at her decease what property
she has or has to be divided is among the
children - It is my will and desire that my
two negroes Sam and Judy at my wife Anne's decease
shall have their lives - and I appoint
my wife Anne my Executor and my son John
Sammons my executor to put this my
last Will and Testament in full force
and under my hand and seal this 11th of January

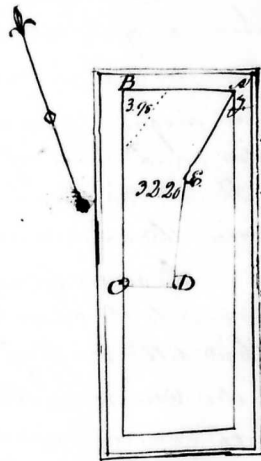

your order made at the residence of Joseph Carter
Dec^r on the 12th Day of December 1812 and proceeded
to allow in the land and negroes of said latter
to Elizabeth Carter widow and relief of said
Joseph died as follows To wit The boundary or
division line to begin near the east corner of the
said land so as to run in the center between
spring in a straight line to the center between
the barn and bush field till you pass the
barn then turning the course in the direc-
tion of the fence which comes down to the
other corner of the barn which course is to
extended so far as to include fully and
