County of Maryland at their March Court 1825 to the undersigned  
decreed appointing them Commissioners to allot to said <sup>heir</sup> ~~heirs~~  
Sapp Madox and relief of Lewis Sapp her dower in the personal  
estate of her deceased husband and by leave to submit the following  
is their allotment of said dower.

One third of the money arising from sales of property, to wit:  
after payt. of dues &c they find the acct. \$36.10 and  
Mrs. G. is entitled to her share of her dower with the exception of dute \$26.10  
On the appraisement of the slaves we find their aggregate  
to be \$300. We find that Jack, Lucy, Aaron, and Daniel negroes  
belonging to her are sold to her as her dower in the slave, and to the sum of \$1550.00

Which I am Cashed 300 dollars in Silver of being paid for the value of the Slaves, we have therefore given said Widow Credit for the Settlements her well as due for the equivalent of said Slaves in Commutation Paper for Settlement &c of which is kept by myself & submitted by
