Agreeably to an order of the honorable the County Court of Sepaminc
County to us directed we the undersigned being duly sworn
do proceed to lay off and allot unto Frances Bryant widow
of Edward Bryant dec her dower in his real personal Estate
and report as follows. That we have Rich. Heckley the deputy
Surveyor to lay off Eighty seven and a half acres of the land including
the main House agreeably to an annexed plat and
bounded as follows to wit Beginning at corner
in Right & corner and running thence S 21° 41' 15"
to a stone at Bence S 63° 02' 4" poles
to C a stone thence N 21° 01' 15" poles to D
stone near Hops 140 alls corner in the
Siminary line thence North 65° 10' 22" 4 poles to the beginning

Containing Eighty Seven & a half acres which we conceived prior to the conveniences to be equivalent to one hundred acres the one third of the whole tract, hence proceeded to allot her share in the slaves and have allotted here Negro woman Lavinia and negro Girl Eliza of the value of seven hundred dollars the third of the value of the slaves being \$146 we then proceeded to allot to her the following personal property to wit

Barkley & Mason Singleton Guardians of Sally & M^{rs} Barkley
infant heirs of Jas Barkley decd and find that there was a balance
due as per Settlement of the Court in 1819 of \$1223.71 in their
hands & we have closed the Settlement of Disbursements Receipts
up to the present date & find that there is a balance due the heirs
from thence of \$1438.43 agreeably to the within account all
of which is respectfully submitted to the Court (W. Mice)
We further report that there is the interest of \$968.04 from James Caving
5 years to wit from Aug 1814 up to Aug 1819 at which James Caving
then we commenced disbursements neglected by James Gamble & Dr. W. C.
Commissioners agreeably to the admissions of the Guardians the
interest will be for that time \$290.41 cents which added to
\$1438.43 will leave a balance due from the Guardians
of \$1728.84 cents
