To my Grand Daughter Susanna Pinston Daughter of my son John Pinston at my death, One Feather Bed and furniture Also a Bow and Hatch 3. To my Grand Daughter Susanna Elizabeth Pinston Daughter of my son Francis Pinston One Feather Bed and furniture also my Bureau to be to my son Robert Pinston at my death, one pair of Beddles and a Saddle Coat 5th The Balance of the Household and Stock in at my death together with my part of the Crop and after my debt duty and funeral expenses are paid to be equally divided between my son John and Francis Pinston 6th Whereas my son Francis Pinston hath a Bed and furniture of mine in possession at this time I Give and bequeath said Bed and furniture to my Grand Daughter Judith Anne Pinston The above Divisions and their legal heirs forever I hereby constituted and appoint my son John Pinston and Francis Pinston as Executors to this my last will and testament Given under my hand and seal this Twentieth day of July in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and eighteen -
