First I give and bequeath to my son, ^{Samuel} Henry two negroes (a wit) Peggy and Oliver I also give and bequeath to my son-in-law Hugh Christman one negro boy named Stephen I also give and bequeath to my daughter Hannah Christman and negro man named Lilly and her increase to do with as she my said daughter may think proper I also give and bequeath to my daughter Betty Gyle one negro girl named Polly to do with as she my said daughter may think proper It is also my will that the Hundred dollars that I held Samuel Rice note for should be equally divided between Margaret wife of James Robertson, Hannes Christman and Betty Gyle my daughter It is also my will that my grandson Geo. S. Christman & John M. Henry should be my executors to this my last will and testament in witness I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 11 day of March 1820 signed and acknowledged in the presence of
