May the 19<sup>th</sup> 1823 as it is appointed to

all men once to die I John Moore do make and ordain  
 this my last will and testament In the first place  
 I order and it is my will that all my just debts and  
 funeral Charges be paid by Executors here after to be  
 appointed and it is my desire that my wife Fanny Moore  
 shall have the benefit and possession of my Dwelling  
 house during her life and an interest in the out houses such  
 as may suit her Conveniences during her life and a main  
 enance from the plantation during her life I will to my  
 wife a horse her choice of all my stock and her saddle  
 and her own bed and its furniture such as she may choose  
 I will to my wife during her life the use of my house hold  
 and kitchen furniture such as is not included in the following  
 distribution these at her death are to remain on the  
 plantation to my Daughter Fanny I have given her

308 portion of my property that I allow to her  
 to my son William I have given that portion of my property  
 to that I allow to him to my daughter Mary I have given  
 that portion of my property that I allow to her to my daughter  
 the Elder I have given that portion of my property that  
 I allow to my daughter Nancy I have given her that

 the Elder I shall give one horse to be worth twenty Dollars  
 and ten cows to be worth twelve Dollars each and two pigs  
 and bed furniture that she now has in her possession and  
 one trunk worth seven Dollars to my son John Moore

 lets and the remainder of the stock that remains after the  
 above named distributions are made to be his and his heirs for  
 ever provided that the sd John Moore shall continue to take  
 good care of my unfortunate son George and should sd John  
 Moore refuse to keep the above named George major twenty  
 and comfortably the sd plantation shall be held by Geo-  
 ge Moore for to secure his support during the sd George  
 Moore's life and at his death the sd plantation shall  
 fall on to the sd John Moore and his heirs for ever and  
 I bequeath all my wearing apparel to my son  
 George and lastly I constitute and appoint David James  
 Anthony Breckinridge Reynolds and Daniel Anthony  
 Executors of this my last will and testament signed and  
 sealed and acknowledged in the presence of Daniel Anthony  
 Bigsby and others
