of said 4 Children If ^{they} all the rest and residue of my estate be
personal or mixed I do desire and direct to be equally divided
between my two children James and my Daughter Sally and to
them and their heirs forever 5^{thly} My negro man Ben at my death
is to be free 6^{thly} having hereunto given unto my two daughters
Polly Overstreet and Sam Ficklin as much of my Estate as they
are entitled to I do hereby declare that they are not to receive any part
portion of my Estate in any way till after lastly I do hereby
appoint my friend Abraham Logan my executor to this my
last will and Testament In testimony Whereof I have unto set
my hand and seal this 11th day of October 1817
