I give to my son John Campbell forty acres of land to include his improvement whenon he now lives, also give to my son Robert Campbell forty acres of land to be laid off at the North east corner of the tract whenon I now live: the balance of my Land & all my Estate both real & personal it is my will should be sold to the highest bidder for cash and the proceeds of the sale or money arising

387 from S. Sale distributed in the following manner etc -
 To my Daughter Polly Johnson I give Sixty Dollars, and to my
 Daughter Sally Campbell I give one hundred & twenty Dollars,
 and to my son Robert Campbell I give twenty five Dollars, and to
 my Grand Daughter Betty Campbell twenty five Dollars, and to my son
 Campbell I give twenty five Dollars to be given to her as soon
 as she becomes of the age of twelve years, I give to my son Robert
 Campbell one Bed & furniture I give to my Daughter Sally
 Campbell her bed & furniture her Bureau & one Chair the Balance
 of the money which shall still remain after all my Just Debts are
 paid it is my wish & desire that it should be equally divided between
 my children, namely: Matthew Campbell, James Campbell, Peter
 Campbell, Nancy Eng. land, John Campbell, Polly Johnson, Robert
 Campbell & Sally Campbell including the amount of the beds of the
 tract of land given to my two sons John & Robert, which if I should
 shall value to more than their equal share then they shall pay up
 the Balance to the other Legacies of the tract should value to less
