personal or mixed I do desire and direct to be equally divided  
between my two children James and my Daughter Sally and to  
them and their heirs forever 5<sup>th</sup> My wife Sarah Ben at my death  
is to be free 6<sup>th</sup> having herebefore given unto my two daughters  
Polly Overstreet and Sam Ficklin as much of my Estate as they  
are entitled to I do hereby declare that they are not to receive any  
portion of my Estate in any real 10<sup>th</sup> share lastly I do hereby  
appoint my friend Abraham Logan my executor to this my  
last will and Testament In testimony Whereof I have unto set  
my hand and seal this 11<sup>th</sup> day of October 1817

In the name of God Amen - I Ezekiel Haydon of Spangin County and State of Kentucky Being Weak of Body but of Sound and Perfect Mind and Memory blessed be almighty god for the same do make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following Viz - I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Polly Haydon the land on which I now live (after my lawful debts are paid) to be sold after my decease as soon as possible and sales give and bequeath unto her a negro girl named Phillis and a negro Boy named Jackson and also a negro boy named Henderson during her life and it is my desire that all my floor and house hold and kitchen furniture of every kind together with three Negroes herein named to be sold the names of the negroes are Lewis, Scipio, Ham, Lude and Peg and the money which my stock and furniture and three Negroes will bring when sold all of it to be given to my beloved Wife Polly Haydon to be disposed of in the manner and form following Viz - To my Daughter Peggy Hawkins I give and bequeath five Dollars - I give and bequeath unto my Grandson Weston County five hundred Dollars - I give and bequeath unto my Granddaughter Polly Smith five hundred Dollars also to our Grandson Clayton County five hundred Dollars and as he is not of age it is my desire that his grandmother my wife, shall purchase land for him with his part or if not to appropriate and apply it to the most prudent and profitable use for him - And to my Daughter Mary Carr I give and bequeath One thousand Dollars to be equally divided among six of her Children namely Robert Carr, Philip Carr, Ezr. Haydon, Gally Carr and William Carr and Elvira Carr It is my desire that this money must be given unto my Daughter Carr to be divided amongst her Children herein named as soon as it can conveniently be collected and it is my Will and Desire that my Son Life Haydon is to have One Dollar I having given him his part formerly, and in the next place It is my will that my Grandchildren Philip Haydon and John Haydon have Two thousand Dollars apiece or each of them is to have this much which is to left in my Wifes hands for them until they come of age and in the Event of her Death before that period shall arise It is his option to appoint the person or persons in whom

He can repose confidence sufficient to put it in his or their hands for safe keeping to be delivered to them as they come of age - My Wife has chosen rather to dispose of the Negroes stated in this my last Will and Testament to be sold either at private or public sale as she may think proper any money that is left after my Negroes each legatee or legatee named her and her heirs as before stated and after all my lawful debts shall have been paid such money my wife is to have at her disposal and for her dearest support during her natural life and she may leave the Negroes I will to her and her money and property that she may have to whom she pleases at her Death - And I do hereby constitute and appoint my beloved Wife Polly Haydon Executrix and my Son Life Haydon Coexecutor of this my last Will and Testament hereby Revoking & disannulling all former Wills and Testaments by me made - In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 19<sup>th</sup> day of October and in the year of our Lord 1818
