1st I give and bequeath to my daughter Nancy Meloy at my death the following Property one Negro Woman named Agnes together with said Agnes Liza Liza Cake & Pans. 2nd To my Grand Daughter Susanna Pinston Daughter of my son John Pinston at my death, One Feather Bed and furniture also a Bow and Hatch 3rd To my Grand Daughter Susanna Elizabeth Pinston Daughter of my son Francis Pinston One Feather Bed and furniture also my Bureau 4th To my son Robert Pinston at my death, one pair of Kittles and a Dutch Oven 5th The Balance of the Household and Stock at my death together with my part of the Crop and after my debt duty and funeral expenses are paid to be equally divided between my son John and Francis Pinston 6th Whereas my son Francis Pinston hath a Bed and furniture of mine in possession at this time I give and bequeath said Bed and furniture to my Grand Daughter Judith Anne Pinston The above Divisions and their legal heirs forever I hereby constitute and appoint my son John Pinston and Francis Pinston as Executors to this my last will and testament Given under my hand and seal this Twentieth day of July in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and eighteen -

his " At the Death of my wife my estate is to be equally
Divided Among all my Children Viz John, Martha,
James and Alexander Dorem Except the Negro Girl above
named But should my Executors think it best to sell
the land sooner they have full power to do so and to
Divide the balance of my Estate as above mentioned
And Lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my Wife
Elizabeth Dorem my Executrix and my son John Dorem &
son Alexander Dorem my Executors to this my last Will and Testament, I give
under my hand and Seal this 11th day of March 1846
